## AFFILIATE SCHEME

### Introduction

The tourdefrancetips.com affiliate scheme allows you to receive a commission on sales, where you send us the sale from your site via a link.

This is a simple process, and allows you to get paid via PayPal.

TDF Tips uses ejunkie to manage affiliate sales and commissions, with instructions on signing up and adding link codes included below.

TDF Tips has multiple products, so you can use the “Hop Link” which simply links to the TDF Tips products page, or you can link back to specific products, which in general is more relevant to your content.

### Signing up and getting the Code

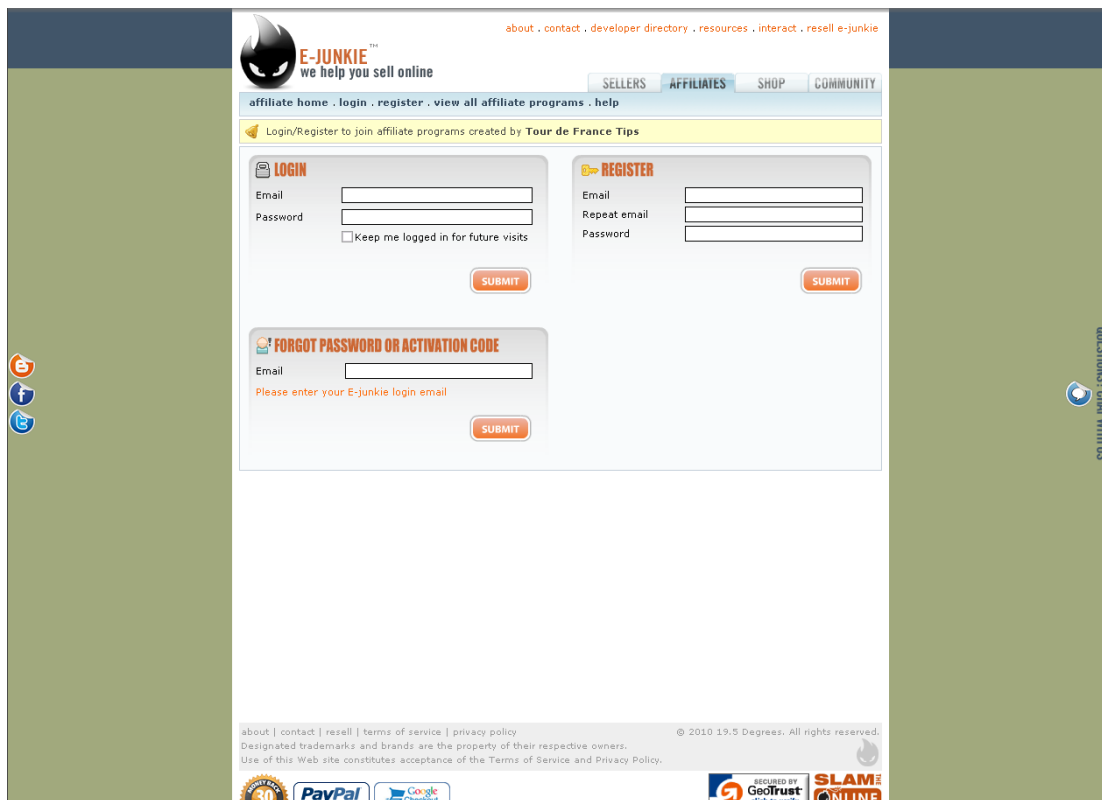


Figure 1 The login/register screen

Using the link [here](#), you are taken to a login screen to sign up (see Figure 1).

If you already have an ejunkie account, you can simply log in, instead of registering.

You will need a [PayPal](#) account before starting.

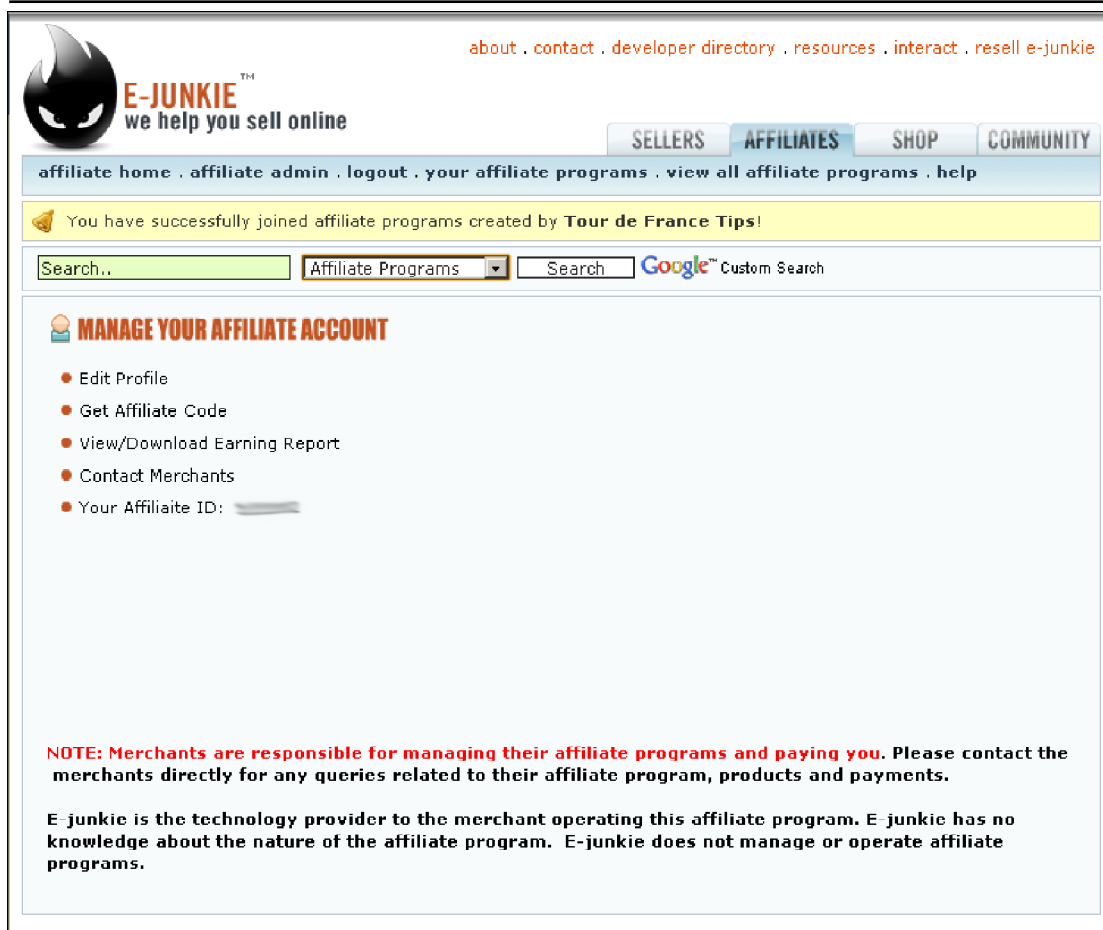


Figure 2 Click “Get Affiliate Code”

After logging in, you are taken the affiliate administration screen (Figure 2). As you came here from the link on [TDF Tips](#), you'll automatically be provided with the TDF Tips affiliate products.

Simply choose "Get Affiliate Code".

You’ll then have Tour de France Tips appear. Click the “Get Affiliate Code” button (Figure 3).

Go to the bottom section where it says “Get Product Specific Links”. Choose the product you want and click the “Get Affiliate Code” button (Figure 4).

## Linking Back

After you have your code, you insert it anywhere on your site, changing the anchor text from “Click here to view more details” to whatever you want.

You can also use any of the images below.

They are located in a file [here](#) [zip file].

Alternatively, you can copy the text in the quotation marks “https:....#####” and paste this into bit.ly. Simple copy the text highlighted light black in the figure below (the dark black is the suppression of some private Ids) and paste into bit.ly. This will give you a shortcode to use!
